#### **Handgun training class debrief:**

Sergeant Bill Duggan of the Maynard Police Department recently held a class called "Introduction to handguns" in our action range. The class was offered free to all members and we had a great turnout. There was a wide range of experience levels, from those that carry for self-defense on a semi-regular basis, to those that have yet to obtain their license to carry. By the end of the 4-Hour class, all students were putting rounds on paper, even those that had never shot a gun before. Sergeant Duggan is going to continue these classes in a set of escalating skill levels over the coming months. If there are any openings in upcoming classes we will make sure to announce it.

### **Upcoming Tournaments**

1. Maynard v. Riverside at Riverside, November 4th, (a 2 or possibly 3-gun event: Skeet and 5-Stand; possibly Skeet; Wobble Skeet; and 5-Stand). I am in charge of organizing that. - Types of ammunition
- Cleaning and storage of Firearms
- Massachusetts laws pertaining to permit applications, firearms storage and transportation

Upon course completion, an NRA Course Certificate and a Massachusetts Safety Certificate will be issued.

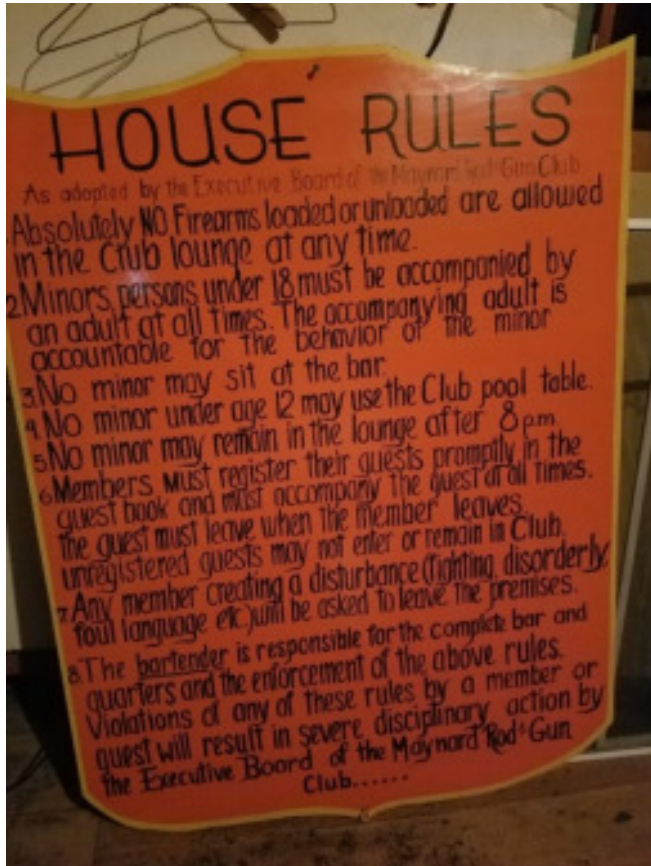
If momentum continues, we should finish at another 21st century high for membership with nearly 450 regular full members! That's up substantially by over 100 over the past two years.
