Class Description: Learn many valuable wild edibles for nutrition, first aid and medicine in a foraging class! Late summer is a great time to find wild seeds, nuts, mushrooms, and medicinal herbs. We will cover-Foraging Safety, Nutritional and Medicinal value, Cooking and Preservation tips, all while foraging wild edibles and letting folks touch, smell, taste, and collect them. A lot of information will be covered in this class, so take pictures and notes of the edibles that most interest you. Bring plastic bags to collect herbs, paper or cloth bags for seeds and mushrooms, insect repellent, and bottled water. If you wish you can bring shears & a pocket knife.
