2017 MRGC Membership Update & Mandatory Range Officers Meeting

9AM Saturday, March 11th & 9AM and Sunday, March 12th.

THANK YOU to the more than 400 members have paid their 2017 dues. We are still, however, waiting on payments from many we know and love. Please settle up as soon as you can.

Winter is throwing its last few haymakers, but the **Annual Range Officers's (RO) Meeting** is just around the corner. The meeting will be held at 9AM Saturday, March

11th & 9AM Sunday, March 12th. <u>Please note: You only need to attend one of these</u> <u>two days</u>. We're hard at work preparing the credentials for all paid 2017 members whose memberships qualify them to seek Range Officer privileges (Regular and Life memberships qualify).

If you haven't paid yet, please do so promptly so we can get you your credentials on time and you can enjoy uninterrupted range access.

At the Annual RO meeting, you'll get your 2017 membership card! Since we see so many of you at the Annual RO meeting, we are holding the 2017 Membership Cards for distribution there. (After those meetings we will mail Membership Cards to those to members who've paid up but cannot attend either of those dates). If you have not paid your dues for 2017 as of yet, you will be able to pay in person at the RO Meeting.

You'll also get your 2017 Range Officer Cards at the Annual RO meeting, presuming you are a previously qualified member and are paid up in full for 2017. **Please bring your 2016 blue card to verify your current RO status.**

You'll also get a hard copy of the new range rules and a lanyard and card holder for your RO card.

Your Range Officer ID card will be attached to a card carrier displaying the demographic information on file with the Club. During the meeting, please review and update any incorrect information we have, answer all the questions on the card carrier, and sign the card carrier, and your membership and RO cards. Please be sure to provide E-Mail addresses to reduce the Club's administrative expenses.

At the end of the Meeting please TURN IN your updated and signed CARD CARRIER. We will retain or reinstate Range Officer status and access and update information based only the return of signed cards.

Those who don't attend **one of the** meetings will have their range officer status and their range access suspended or revoked until they attend an alternate RO training, **which will be held at a later date.**

Subsequent to the Annual RO Meeting, Range Officer Cards will be made available to members only after the Rife &Pistol Committee **verifies a** members's range officer status.

Massachusetts Junior Conservation Camp - Aug. 6th - Aug. 18, 2017

<u>Deadline of April 15, 2017</u> - We are actively seeking two campers of MR&GC members' immediate families to attend this Mass Jr. Conservation Camp.

MR&GC will sponsor up to 50% for each camper. The camp costs \$850 per child. This camp is run by Mass Wildlife and will be held from August 6th - August 18, 2017 at the Horace Moses Scout Reservation in Russell, MA. This camping experience is open to both boys and girls ages 13 to 17 years old who enjoy the outdoors. While at camp they will learn outdoor survival skills, plant identification, tracking skills, fishing, hunting, boating, campfire cooking, firearm safety, shooting skills, archery, plus many other skills needed to become an outdoors person. A letter from R&P Committee Chairman:

As the new chairman of the R&P committee, I have asked the committee for some big improvements in the coming year, and we begin with a new detailed set of rules and procedures to cover the Rifle and Pistol ranges. We think you will be happy with these new 2017 rules because they clarify several questions that seem to always come up and they put into black and white some of the collective knowledge that has always been passed along verbally. Please keep an eye on your inbox for a separate email with a link to the new rules and procedures in the coming days. The new rules will be online for your review for a few days before they go into effect, and we welcome your comments via email at

rifleandpistol@<u>maynardrodandqunclub.com</u> . The 2017 rules will officially take effect Monday, March 13th, after the annual Rifle and Pistol meetings.

The annual meetings will be held this year on both March 11th and 12th starting at 9 am each day. (You only need to attend one) We will be distributing hard copies of the 2017 rules and reviewing some of the notable updates. This also when you'll get the new combinations to the gate & range box locks.

The meeting is being held both days in order to accommodate those who cannot make it to one or the other. In order to maintain Range Officer status, you must attend the meeting on either of these two days. Failure to attend will cause your range privileges to be revoked until the R&P can schedule another meeting at their convenience.

Please note that the indoor range will continue to be closed on Wednesday and Thursday nights from 7pm til closing, as the Club's pistol teams and junior rifle program will be using it through the winter. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. The Club's two pistol teams are doing well this season and remain strong competitors. Likewise, the Junior Rifle Program is now in full swing and doing well also.

Lastly, muzzle discipline continues to be an issue and because of that, the R&P Committee urges you to take a few minutes and watch this video, and think about what you can do to contribute to the culture of safety that we try to instill in all of our members. please give it two minutes and you'll watch the whole thing.
