**IF YOU BUILD IT THEY WILL COME**. Many new Skeet & Trap Committee members have joined and are now integrated as RO's and shooting with us regularly across all disciplines: Skeet, Wobble Skeet, Trap and 5-Stand, providing increased vitality to all of the shotgun shooting sports and events; additional volunteer manpower for operations and work details; and generating more revenue from clay fees to apply to replacements and improvements.

**PREPAID DISCOUNT COUPON PROGRAM**. The Prepaid Discount clays fees coupon program has been hugely successful. Members appreciate the discount savings on clays fees, especially for the most active shooters, but also for all members ease of payment with coupons in correct denominations for standard clays fees, instead of being hassled with bringing cash, making change, etc. Most significantly, the program has accelerated Skeet & Trap Committee's cash flow, allowing more frequent upgrades and replacements to be performed to its shooting facilities and equipment. Moreover, it has substantially lessened the administrative burdens on our volunteers who are responsible for collecting, depositing and accounting for the clays fees. Security cameras have been installed and are operational in the Shooters Den and on both Skeet fields.

### Maynard v. Riverside Fun Shoot a Blast By Steve Winnick, Skeet & Trap Committee Secretary

A squad of ace shooters from our Skeet and Trap Committee squared off against Riverside Rod & Gun Club located in Hudson, MA on Saturday 27, 2019 for a three shotgun (Skeet; Trap and 5-Stand) Fun Shoot tournament at Riverside.

Maynard's squad of Top Guns consisted of Mike Cavanaugh, Alan Humbert, Jim Leuck, Peter Lonero, Joe Milavec, Bryant Shea, Dwight Warren, and Steve Winnick.

The two clubs have been in friendly competition and shooting fellowship for years now, trading off at each other's club for two tournaments a year, an informal "Fun Shoot" followed by a mano a mano "Club Tournament" for the coveted "Club Trophy." So most of the shooters on

both sides are on a first-name basis and considered personal friends, and the clubs are closely matched, which adds to the excitement and enjoyment of shooting competitively against one another.

Despite Riverside besting Maynard at this year's Fun Shoot, it is no exaggeration to say it was a blast for everyone who participated; and no small consolation that Maynard's own Capo di Tutti Capi Top Gun, Jim Leuck, took High Overall in the three events (25 Straight in Skeet; 19 in Trap; and 20 in 5-Stand) from among all of the eighteen shooters that competed on both sides. Other Maynard standouts were Peter Lonero (23 in Skeet); Mike Cavanaugh (22 in Skeet and 21 in 5-Stand); and Dwight Warren (21 in Skeet).

Maynard's Skeet & Trap Committee is steadfastly committed to winning back the Club Trophy from Riverside at this year's tournament (to be held at Riverside on Saturday, November 16, 2019; see details below), and will be training hard to make that a reality.
